**DROP OFF /PICK UP UPDATE**: - parents should stay off pavement areas during school time , - all visitors , early pick ups and sign-ins should start from office , all walkthrough walkers are being redirected from school premises , student boundaries are in-place to avoid hits from playing sports students . , reducing foot traffic at school busses run line to avoid accidents . – request submitted to the City to come and visit Kiss and Ride Line to improve traffic and better planning & suggestions Expect everyone to follow the rules. – Morning drop off starts at 9 am with teachers supervision on the pavement . If bus is late , the driver calls the office to collect the kids .
